Granted by the Court and as an alternative to Prison, Formal Probation provides an offender with the benefit of supervision in the community by a Probation Officer. Offenders are given court ordered terms and conditions of Probation to follow for three to five years.

Juvenile Court Terminology. Adjudication [of Delinquency] Analogous to an adult "conviction," it is a formal finding by the juvenile court, after an adjudicatory hearing or the entering of a guilty plea/admission, that the juvenile has committed the act for which he or she is charged.

My child has been arrested, what can I expect? There are two types of arrest/referral – paper and physical. If your child is physically arrested and brought to the detention facility and held there, this is called a physical referral. The parents/guardians will be notified upon his or her arrival to the Pima County Juvenile Court Center.
